During the period of the project I had the opportunity to be exposed to the professional photography style.


We were covering the matches of the local volleyball team of Baia Mare, Știința Explorări.

We covered other sports events as well, like *Enduro Snow Ice Race*, the opening of *Raliul Maramureșului*, and as an initiated activity from my side I covered one of the matches of CS Marta.

Also as a team we covered *Cupa Primăverii* - rhythmic gymnastics.











Team Building

Since I joined the project we had regular team meetings, which helped us to know more about each other and how to find our common languages, since we are all from different countries with various cultural backgrounds.

We had board games, card games, cooking and exchanging cultures and all of that enriched my knowledge and understanding about different cultures and life styles as an Egyptian volunteer who spent all her life in Egypt.



Trip to Timișoara

We went to Timişoara to cover the match of Ştiinţa volleyball team there. Our trip to the city didn't end at taking photos of the match, but also of the places in which people can practice sports. We also discovered the city by walking around and visiting the landmarks of it.

I had the chance to meet other coordinators from Romania and Italy; to know how the collaborations work and more about the other opportunities for volunteers even out of Romania.



Mentoring Sessions

Mentoring sessions to me are the cure for every bad impact of being in a foreign country.


During the sessions we handled every trivial detail which affected or could've affected my productivity or my mental and emotional health.

Trainings

During the project I attended 2 trainings. First one was the On-Arrival Training, in which I got exposed to ESC in a deeper way with other volunteers from around Romania.

Second training I had is the Mid-Term Evaluation, in which we evaluated our projects and our learning process, and the trainers introduced us to other opportunities.



Cultural Workshops

We had different cultural workshops; for example, Christmas, *mărţişoare*, Easter and *mucenici*.

Some events we shared with public like *mărțișoare* in which we distributed the gifts to the ladies in the streets, and in *Mucenici* we shared it with other international volunteers in Baia Mare.









Youth Week

With Yellow Shirts youth day is a week!

Actually we wanted to do as many activities as we can with the local youth in the city, so we had youth movie night, intercultural dialogue, sports games day, board games, and youth exhibition in which we had also a participant from Libya and she shared her art and it was really amazing experience!





Writing Articles

During the 8-months volunteering I had to write different articles.

Some of them were to tell my feedback regarding specific activities, some were about sport and healthy life style routine, while others were on SBT.


Translation

I translated 2 manual books from English to Arabic, which I found really interesting to make people know more about sports and the different types of it.

Quiz Night/ Card Game Night

We had 2 quiz nights per month in which we had the chance to know new information and to exchange knowledge!

Also after the quiz we had the chance to play some card games and to exchange various games from different countries.



Sport and Cultural Movie Nights

I facilitated more than 6 movie nights, I enjoyed sharing it with other volunteer and attendees, and having a conversation about it afterwards with them was a great part of the event.

In these nights our main goal is to promote sport so we had movies like "I, Tonya", "Home Team", "Million Dollar Baby", etc. and also we dedicated part of it to the youth in order to interact with the movie. We always had discussions after it. For example for "COCO" we talked about family in different communities.



Promoting Local Clubs

I searched, visited and made interviews with local sport clubs in Baia Mare, taking photos of the club and writing articles to share it on our platforms. This activity helped me personally to know more about the sportive potentials of the city, as there are dancing clubs for all kinds of styles, martial art clubs, not to mention handball and volleyball ones.

The value of the activity is to help people to know the available sports in their city and to help these clubs to keep up the good work.

We talked about the traditional Egyptian dishes and the story behind it, and we tried Kushary and rice pudding together.











V4V Short Cultural presentation



Hikes


We had our hikes inviting other volunteers to join us.


The diary had a great impact to follow my personal progress as well, as checking where was I and comparing it with what I reached; was an important critical way to check-up on my process.
