FAQs

Here you'll find the most useful information to have a nice stay in Baia Mare.





Q: Where Can I find a laundry?

A: you'll find a lot of laundries in the area and the recommended one is Spălătorie Curățătorie Haine, Baia Mare- hainecurate.

Q: Do we have shops around?

A: You'll find big shops like Kaufland, Carrefour, Lidl and others which work till 20 or 2, and you'll find the non-stop shops as well, which work 24/7. Pharmacies and green groceries are close by. Not to forget to mention the local markets; we have the weekly ones every Fri. and Sat. and the permanent one at the old town.

Q: what can I find at the local market?

A: Mostly you'll find homemade products like *zacuscă*, dried fruits, nuts, juices, syrup, meat, and handmade accessory and Romanian souvenirs.



Q: what activities can I do?

A: the city is small but there are a lot of activities that you can enjoy during your stay. You can go hiking, camping, cycling, running and other different sports around the city, swimming and visiting the countryside of Maramureş.



Q: Where can I do these activities?

A: About the hiking you can use the app Mapsme, and it'll guide you to the trails of the mountains and the hills around the city. Besides you can ask about the hiking map if you wanna be the perfect tourist! For running there are many parks like Mara Park, Municipal Park (Queen Mary) and Central Park. There are many swimming pools in Baia Mare which have good quality service.
